The Diploma with Academic Honors recognizes the student who has gone beyond the minimal academic requirements or has distinguished himself academically through additional course work. The Academic Honors Diploma is recommended for students taking college preparatory courses; with this in mind, the following criteria have been established and are in addition to the general diploma criteria : (See the MDHSA Diploma Guide and the MDHSA Annual Summary Form and Transcript for general diploma requirements). For Academic Honors consideration, ALL REQUIREMENTS BELOW MUST BE MET AND CHECKED (unless otherwise noted) by the end of the senior year. Honors Application AND required attachments are due with the Diploma Request Form and should not be submitted separately. GRADING REQUIREMENTS
Students applying for Academic Honors must use letter grades or percentages on academic courses, not Pass/Fail.
Students should have an 'A' average (90% or better) in all academic courses. Difficulty of subject matter will be taken into consideration if there are any 'B's' on the Transcript.
SUBJECT REQUIREMENTS
1. English - ALL REQUIRED
The student who desires an Academic Honors diploma will demonstrate that his reading selections have challenged him in some way. <i>Reading selections for the honors diploma should include a majority of high school or college level selections.</i> With that in mind, the student should have had an extensive reading list, with selections from more than three of the following categories, in his portfolio for each evaluation: FICTION, NON-FICTION, BIBLE, ESSAYS, POETRY, MAGAZINE ARTICLES, CLASSICS, TECHNICAL
The student has had instruction in literary analysis. Much of this information is found in literature texts or programs, or other materials. This includes learning terms such as: SIMILE, METAPHOR, PLOT, FORESHADOWING; RHYME, RHYTHM, AND METER IN POETRY
The student has completed at least one research paper that is a minimum of five pages, and includes at least two separate type of resources, such as internet articles (excluding Wikipedia), published books or texts, interviews, or any other type of academic media where the student obtains significant knowledge in the topic. The report should include: (See English textbooks for examples of research papers.) COVER PAGE, OUTLINE, FOOTNOTES OR ENDNOTES, BIBLIOGRAPHY
Do not send the research paper to MDHSA. The evaluator should verify that the research paper for the Honors
<u>Diploma is well written and meets the above guidelines.</u>
