WHAT WE DO

Temple Pre-College Programs are an excellent opportunity for high school students to experience what life is really like as a student at Temple University. With programs for grades 10 through 12, high school students can explore potential majors by taking non-credit workshops or undergraduate courses, experience residential life on Temple's campus, and network with Temple's faculty and potential future classmates.

PRE-COLLEGE PROGRAMS



Pre-College Workshops invite students to experience Temple University academics while exploring potential college majors through non-credit workshops. Topics include health and medicine, writing, the arts, business, politics and social justice, leadership, pre-law, college readiness, and more.



Summer Academy students will experience the academics, energy, and culture of Temple University as they take a college course and 2 non-credit academic workshops. Students who earn a B or better in their college course earn a \$1,000/year tuition grant towards their Temple undergraduate education.



Summer Scholars will join Temple undergraduates in attending 2 college courses over the summer term and earn up to 8 credits, developing interests in various academic fields. Students who earn a B or better in their college course earn a \$1,000/year tuition grant towards their Temple undergraduate education.

FINANCIAL AID

Financial aid is available for students attending our Pre-College Programs. More scholarship opportunities are available for Philadelphia residents. Aid typically does not cover the full cost of the program, and proof of income and an essay are required as part of the financial aid application.

HOW TO APPLY

Applications are free. To apply, students must meet these requirements:

- Minimum 3.0 GPA
- Essay submission (500 words max)
- 1 recommendation form (Summer Academy & Summer Scholars only)

Students have until 3/1 (Early Bird deadline) or 4/1 (Regular Deadline) to submit their application.

Once a student completes their application, the application will be reviewed by the Temple Pre-College office and students will be notified of their decision and class choices by 3/15 (Early Bird) or 5/1 (Regular). Students will then be given a list of next steps to complete to confirm their enrollment.
